



Governor Macquarie named Liverpool after Robert Banks Jenkinson, otherwise known as the 2nd Earl of Liverpool. Jenkinson was the Secretary of the Colonies when Governor Lachlan Macquarie founded Liverpool in 1810. Later known as Lord Liverpool, he became both the youngest and the longest-serving Prime Minister of the United Kingdom since 1806. We have been the custodians of Liverpool's history since 1959 and are dedicated to the research, conservation, preservation and restoration of local history and the preservation of written, photographic and physical materials for present and future users.
